Goat Rules:

- Up to 4 Market Wether/Commercial Doe goats may be shown per exhibitor—Meat Goats Only.
- Goats must be born after January 1, 2016.
- Goats will be shown by gender/weight.
- Goats must be clipped and fit for show in order to participate.
- No tubes or blankets allowed on goats during weigh-in. Goats will be allowed over the scale one time and weight will be recorded by the show chairman.
- Materials or paint may not be used to change or enhance the color of an animal. If natural color is altered the animal will be disqualified.
- No drenching and muzzles are allowed, infractions will result in disqualification
- Goats will need to show out of trailer, no pens will be available until conclusion of lamb show.
- Please leave your trailer area clean and free of debris.

Goats need to be in place by 11am, weigh in will be held at 12 Noon. The Meat Goat Show will start at the conclusion of the market lamb show (approximate time 3-3:30 pm)
 Wether classes will show first followed by commercial doe classes.
