

WELCOME JUNIOR SWINE EXHIBITORS TO THE 2016 WISCONSIN SUMMER SPECTACULAR SHOW!

The Central Wisconsin State Fairgrounds in Marshfield is located at 513 E 17th St, Marshfield, WI. Camping is available on the grounds for \$25/night. Please make checks payable to the WLBA and turn in to Jill Alf at the registration desk. Camping spots will be monitored for payment.

Here are a few reminders to make your show a good experience!

- Livestock may arrive from 6-8 pm on Friday—barns will be locked until this time and will be re-locked at 8:30 pm. If you are unable to arrive by 8:00, please plan to arrive in the morning.
- **NEW in 2016!: Kountry Kids 4-H group will have a food stand in the pavilion next to the show palace; food items will include; Scrambled eggs and ham or sausage bake, donuts, pulled pork sandwiches, brats/hotdogs, chips, cookies and various beverages. Please plan to eat on-site and help this local 4-H group do some fund-raising....we appreciate them providing this on-site service!**
- Swine will be penned in the hog barn to the LEFT ONLY of the center ring in the hog barn.
- Weigh in on Saturday morning only this year and is from 7:30 am-8:30 am—scales will close for swine promptly at 8:30 am. Breeding gilts will be shown by age—Market hogs will be shown by weight. Class breaks and a show schedule will be posted for all classes by approximately 10 am on Saturday morning.
- The swine show will start at 10:30 am, starting with breeding gilts, market hogs and then showmanship.
- There are no pre-assigned pens, do not take un-necessary pens for tack or fitting. Put as many pigs in a pen as possible. You will be asked to move tack to allow animals to be penned or combine pens if necessary. In an effort to keep penning tight, please pen right next to someone else to avoid random pens in between exhibitors.
- Exhibitors are required to bring their own bedding. All pens need to be cleaned prior to your departure. Additionally, the fairground does not provide wheel barrels, brooms or pitch forks, so please bring appropriate equipment. Exhibitors will be charged \$25/pen for any pen left un-cleaned. Exhibitors are welcome to show out of trailer as long as the area around your trailer is picked up before you leave.
- The swine show committee would additionally ask for your assistance in cleaning the show-ring before your departure—if everyone helps it should take just a short time to get this done.
- Anyone owing show or membership fees will need to pay them before they are allowed to weigh in.
- WLBA T-shirts can be purchased at the registration table located in the show palace—we have a great theme this year and t-shirts sold extremely well at the Spring Preview show!
- All pigs will need on-the-farm health inspection papers—this is NOT a terminal show.
- Infected pigs or pigs that show signs of contagious diseases will not be allowed to be shown.
- All purebred pigs must have registration papers.

- There will be no educational contest in 2016. If you would be interested in coordinating either a skillathon or a quizbowl in 2017 please contact Jill Alf.
- And last, we are sharing the fairgrounds with another event—we have been very specifically asked by fair management to stay on the ‘livestock side’ of the fairgrounds that we have rented.
