33RD SPRING PREVIEW SHOW
June 8th, 2013 – Jefferson Fair Park, Jefferson, Wisconsin

ENTRY DEADLINE/ENTRY FEES:

May 1, 2013-entries postmarked by this date:

- **Per exhibitor, all species entered:** First (2) entries: \$15.00 per head, 3rd/4th entries: \$10/head, all additional entries: \$5.00/head.
- \$25 WLBA dues must be submitted with entry if not already paid.

May 25, 2013-late entries postmarked by this date:

- **Per exhibitor, all species entered:** First (2) entries: \$30.00 per head, 3rd/4th entries: \$20/head, all additional entries: \$10.00/head.
- \$25 WLBA dues must be submitted with entry form.
- Sheep and swine pens will not be guaranteed to exhibitors entering after May 1-you may be required to show out of your trailer if pen space is no longer available.

MAILING ADDRESS:

ELIGIBILITY:

- Exhibitors must be 8-19 years of age as of January 1, 2013 and Wisconsin residents unless you qualify as an exception. **ALL exhibitors** must be 2013 paid individual or family WLBA members.

EXCEPTIONS:

- The Junior Angus and Hereford Associations will hold their state shows in conjunction with the WLBA show. Out-of-state members and WI members that fall within their association's age limits will allowed to exhibit only in classes sponsored by that breed association.
- The WLBA Spring Preview Market Lamb Show will be a 2013 WLCA sanctioned show--age limits in the market lamb and commercial ewe lamb classes only will follow WCLA age guidelines.
- *New in 2013:* The WLBA Spring Preview Swine Show is a 2013 sanctioned WSPA show. WSPA members only will be allowed to show under their associations age limits. *See WSPA guidelines in swine rule section.

GENERAL SHOW RULES:

- All animals are to be fed, fitted and shown by the exhibitor. Family members and other junior exhibitors are allowed to assist.
- Exhibitors must show their own animals. Any exception to this rule must be cleared with the WLBA show chairman and must not conflict with a sanctioned show rule.
- Registration papers must be in the name of the exhibitor or in his/her parents or farm name. To be eligible for Bred and Owned competition, the breeder and the owner of the animal must be in the exhibitors name only. All purebred animals in each species must have registration papers to exhibit in purebred classes.
- No medicines/drugs may be given to an animal at the show without a vet and show chairman approval.
- Any animal showing symptoms of a contagious disease will not be permitted to show and will need to be taken home.
- Any animal that has been altered by a surgical procedure will be disqualified.
- Sheep and Swine pens will be assigned. Check your exhibitor letter that will be emailed prior to the show or the WLBA website for this information after June 1. Precedence will be given to exhibitors with entries made by May 1.
- All pens, stalls, and fitting areas must be cleaned thoroughly before exhibitors leave. See your exhibitor letter for specific guidelines. Exhibitors will be charged for pens not cleaned.
- There will be no smoking in the barns, use of controlled substances, or alcohol on the grounds by either exhibitors or adults.
- Interpretation of any rule infraction rests with the show committee which has the authority to bar an exhibitor from exhibiting at this show or other WLBA shows.

SHOWMANSHIP:

- Showmanship age within each species is age as of January 1, 2013.

BEEF RULES:

- Exhibitor may show up to 5 heifers and 3 steers.
- Heifers must be born after September 1, 2011. Heifers must be purchased by May 1, 2013. Heifers without papers and crossbred heifers will be shown as a Commercial breed. Purebred heifers must be 75% or more purebred and must carry an ear tattoo corresponding to the registration papers. Heifers will be shown by breed with classes determined after all heifers have been checked in. Exhibitors may also enter cow/calf pairs.
- Steers must be born after January 1, 2012. Steers must carry a state or county fair tag. Steers will be shown by breed and weight. Purebred Angus and Hereford steers need registration papers in the exhibitor's name. If there are less than 5 steers in one breed, that breed will show in an Any Other Breed class. No dairy steers will be shown.
- No steers with horns longer than 1" from the hair line will show. Loosely attached scurs are permitted to show.
- No butt fans allowed.

SWINE RULES:

- All swine exhibitors including WSPA members must be 2013 WLBA members.
- Swine entries do NOT have to be pre-identified-please indicate how many animals you are entering.
- ***WSPA members only** will be allowed to enter up to the day of show without a late entry fee, BUT to allow show management time to make pen assignments anyone who enters after a May 25th postmark deadline will be required to show out of trailer.
- All other rules can be found on the attached document provided by the WSPA.

SHEEP RULES:

- Exhibitors may show up to 4 ewes and 4 rams of each breed they are showing.
- Commercial/wether-type ewes and ewe lambs will be considered a breed and will have their own classes.
- Exhibitors must provide registration papers on purebred breeding sheep. Ewes without proper papers will show as a commercial ewe. Rams without registration papers will not show-commercial/wether-type rams are not allowed. All sheep must carry an ear tag corresponding to registration papers. All female and sexually intact males need scrapie tags.
- Ewes, rams, and lambs must be purchased by June 1, 2013.
- Ewe & Ram Classes: Yearling Ewe/Rams must be born after September 1, 2011. Winter lambs: born between Jan 1-Feb 15, 2013. Spring lambs: born on or after February 16, 2013. Fall lambs: born between Sept 1-Dec 31, 2012.
- Two exhibitors are allowed to show breeding sheep, the exhibitor the sheep is entered under must be on head.
- Market Lamb Classes: Up to 4 market lambs may be shown per exhibitor. Lambs must be born after January 1, 2013.
- Lambs will be shown by breed/weight. If there are less than 5 lambs in a breed, that breed will show in an any other breed class.
- No patch shearing is allowed. Lambs must not have more than one-half inch of wool.
- No tubes or blankets allowed on lambs during weigh-in. Lambs will be allowed over the scale one time and weight and breed determination by the show chairman/committee is final.
- Materials or paint may not be used to change or enhance the color of any animal. If natural color is altered the animal will be disqualified.
- No drenching and muzzles are allowed for breeding or market lambs. Infractions will result in disqualification.

Lead Class: Ewes or wethers may be used in this class. Animal must be owned by immediate family. Entrants shall wear attire made of wool fabrics. The class shall be judged on percentages as follows; 50% on exhibitor attire, 30% on presentation of sheep-showmanship, 20% on personality and knowledge of project of exhibitor during interview. Entrants shall provide the show chairman with a lead class entry form by no later than 8:00 am at the check-in site.

Master Stockman Applications: Master Stockman Award applications will no longer be turned in at the Spring Preview or Summer Spectacular Shows. Applications will be submitted to the WLBA office by January 2, 2014. Please see the WLBA website for more information.

2013 Sanctioned Show Rules

- Sanctioned shows must pay a \$50 sanctioning fee per day.
- Each show must follow the WSPA Show Circuit Rules.
- Show staff will weigh and collect weights of necessary hogs. No declaring of weights permitted.
- Full show results in an electronic version to be provided to a WSPA representative at the conclusion of the show. A jump drive will be provided for ease of providing this information. Full show results include: complete listing of class placings for every class; breed champions; overall champion and reserve champions; placing for all individuals who participate in showmanship. (For example, if there are 10 youth in a showmanship class, then placings from 1 to 10 for that class need to be recorded and included in show results submission)
- Youth must be a paid member of the WSPA prior to point accumulation towards the show circuit. Youth dues are \$15 per individual.
- Wisconsin youth ages 5-21 years old as of January 1, 2013 are eligible to become WSPA youth members.
- Shows are open to any youth ages 5-21 as of January 1, 2013. Out of state youth are allowed to show, however, only youth members of the WSPA will be eligible to collect points.
- Ear notches will be used for hog identification at each of the shows.
- Each breed will have their own class regardless of entry numbers.
- Gilts will be judged as breeding gilts. Purebred gilts will show by age. Crossbred gilts will be shown by weight. All gilts must be born after December 1, 2012.
- Barrows will be shown by breed and weight, but must be born after December 1, 2012.
- Barrows and crossbred gilts may be shown at any weight, however, hogs weighing over 250 pounds prior to June 15 and over 300 after June 15 are not eligible to collect points or participate in championship drives.
- Registration papers must be provided by exhibitor for animals showing as purebreds.
- Individual youth must be present to exhibit their own animal for their points to accumulate in the show circuit.
- Once a pig is exhibited by a WSPA member and points are collected on that pig, no other WSPA member may collect points on that pig the rest of the show circuit including family members.
- Each exhibitor must present Certificate of Veterinary Inspection at each show.
- Showmanship classes will be split into the following age divisions: Novice (5-8); Junior (9-12); Intermediate (13-16); and Senior (17-21). Ages are as of January 1, 2013.
- Any grievances must be presented in writing to a WSPA representative within 24 hours of the incident and accompanied by a \$100 fee.
- Fee will be re-funded if grievance upheld.
- A WSPA representative will be present at each show.
