## **ENTRY DEADLINE/ENTRY FEES:**

**May 15, 2021-early deadline entries must be made by this date and payments mailed/postmarked by this date.**

- Per exhibitor, all species entered: \$15 per entry
- \$30 WLBA annual dues must be submitted with entry if not already paid.
- May 29, 2021-late entries must be made by this date and payments mailed/postmarked by this date. Entry fees are doubled to \$30/entry. Dues should not be doubled.
- There will be no entries accepted after May 29, 2021 (Except Swine)
- Refunds: Entry fees and WLBA dues once paid are non-refundable.

## **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Exhibitors must be 8-21 years of age as of January 1, 2021 and Wisconsin residents unless you qualify as an exception listed below.
- **ALL exhibitors** must be 2021 paid individual or family WLBA members.

## **EXCEPTIONS:**

- The Junior Angus/Hereford Assn's hold their state shows in conjunction with this show. Out-of-state members and WI members that fall within their association's age limits will be allowed to exhibit in classes sponsored by that breed association.
- The WLBA Spring Preview Market Lamb Show will be a 2021 WLCA sanctioned show--age limits in the market lamb and WCLA market ewe lamb classes only will follow WCLA age guidelines.
- The WLBA Spring Preview Swine Show is a 2021 sanctioned WSPA show. WSPA members only will be allowed to show under their association's age limits. \*See [WSPA guidelines](#) on the WSPA website.

## **SCHEDULE:**

### **Saturday, June 5, 2021: SWINE SHOW**

- Arrival: 7 am - Animals may begin to arrive
- Check In/Weigh-In: 7:30 - 8:30 am (All barrows and crossbred gilts must be weighed and all entry information turned into check-in staff).
- Show Begins at 9:30 am (MAP Building)
- Order: Gilts, Barrows, Showmanship

### **Saturday, June 5, 2021: SHEEP SHOW**

- Arrival: 7:00 am – Animals may begin to arrive
- Check In: 7:30 – 9:00 a.m. Declared weights submitted, registration papers checked
- Show Begins at (Sheep Barn): 10:00 am
- Order: Market Lamb Showmanship, Market Lambs, Breeding Sheep Showmanship, Breeding Sheep

### **Saturday, June 5, 2021: GOAT SHOW**

- Arrival: 7:00 am – Animals may begin to arrive
- Check In: 7:30 – 9:00 a.m. Declared weights submitted, Does checked in
- Show Begins at (Sheep Barn): Following Sheep Breeding Stock show
- Order: Showmanship, Market Wethers, Market Does

### **Saturday, June 5, 2021: BEEF SHOW**

- Arrival: 6-9 pm Cattle may begin arriving no earlier than 6 pm to allow sheep/swine exhibitors ample time to depart

### **Sunday, June 6, 2021: BEEF SHOW**

- Arrival: 5-7 am
- Check In: 7-8 am
- Show Begins at (MAP Building/Sheep Barn): 8:30 a.m.
- Order: Spring Preview Heifer/Steer Shows, Spring Preview Showmanship, Hereford/Angus State Shows.

## **GENERAL SHOW RULES/COMMENTS:**

- ANY SPECIES THAT DOES NOT HAVE 20 HEAD PRE ENTERED WILL NOT HAVE A SHOW.

- ALL SPECIES will be required to show out of trailer. We are renting barns for show-ring purposes only. Bring generators and electrical cords if you have them. You will be required to clean up any bedding/debris around your trailer before you leave. Like last year there may be county restrictions; we appreciate your cooperation during these challenging times.
- All animals are to be fed, fitted and shown by the exhibitor. Family members and other junior exhibitors are allowed to assist.
- Exhibitors must show their own animals. Any exception to this rule must be cleared with the WLBA show chairman.
- Registration papers must be in the name of the exhibitor or in his/her parents or farm name. To be eligible for Bred and Owned competition (Beef show only), the breeder and the owner of the animal must be in the exhibitor's name only. All purebred animals in each species must have registration papers to exhibit in purebred classes.
- No medicines/drugs may be given to an animal at the show without a vet and show chairman approval.
- Any animal showing symptoms of a contagious disease will not be permitted to show and will need to be taken home.
- Any animal that has been altered by a surgical procedure will be disqualified.
- Check your exhibitor letter that will be posted online prior to the show or the WLBA website for this information by June 1.
- All fitting areas must be raked and cleaned thoroughly before exhibitors leave. See your exhibitor letter for specific guidelines. Jefferson charges us for space left inappropriately, therefore exhibitors will be charged for areas that are not cleaned up too.
- There will be no smoking in the barns, use of controlled substances, or alcohol on the grounds by either exhibitors or adults.
- Interpretation of any rule infraction rests with the show committee which has the authority to bar an exhibitor from exhibiting at this show or other WLBA shows.

#### **BEEF RULES:**

- Exhibitors may show up to 5 heifers and 3 steers.
- Heifers must be born after September 1, 2019. Heifers must be purchased by May 1, 2021. Heifers without papers and crossbred heifers will be shown as a Commercial breed. Purebred heifers must be 75% or more purebred and must carry an ear tattoo corresponding to the registration papers. Heifers will be shown by breed with classes determined after all heifers have been checked in.
- Steers must be born after January 1, 2020. Steers must carry a state or county fair tag. Steers will be shown by breed and weight. Purebred Angus and Hereford steers need registration papers in the exhibitor's name. If there are less than 5 steers in one breed, that breed will show in an Any Other Breed class. No dairy steers will be shown.
- No steers with horns longer than 1" from the hair line will show. Loosely attached scurs are permitted to show.
- Hereford or Angus Bulls must be born after 9/1/19 to be eligible for show. Hereford or Angus Cow/Calf pairs may be entered. Calf must also be entered individually to be shown in a calf class separately.
- Check-in for all cattle will be done at your trailer.
- Commercial Heifers will show by age, steers will not be weighed, you will be asked to declare a weight and submit it by 8 am.
- PLEASE NOTE: 2021 will again be a "Blow & Go" no-fit show.

#### **SWINE RULES:**

- Since the Spring Preview is a WSPA sanctioned show, WSPA rules will be followed. See WSPA website for more info: <https://www.wisconsinshowpigassociation.com/>
- All barrows and crossbred gilts must be weighed
- Each exhibitor must present a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. If you would like to keep your original inspection form, A COPY MUST BE PROVIDED TO WLBA STAFF DURING CHECK-IN OR ANIMALS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHOW. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Any fees from entry on the day of the show must be paid at check-in.

#### **SHEEP RULES:**

- **All sheep must be checked in with show staff by 9:00 a.m. Any sheep not checked in will not be eligible to show in either show.**
- **NEW in 2021:** There will be a breeding sheep and market lamb showmanship, exhibitors may show in both or either so long as they are entered into each show.
- **NEW in 2021:** All commercial ewes will show within the market lambs show. Yearling and ewe lambs will be eligible. There will not be a separate commercial ewe class in the breeding sheep show.
  - Commercial ewes will be shown by weight not age, please make sure to bring them through the scale upon check-in.
- **NEW in 2021:** Commercial ram entries will be allowed.
- If there are less than 5 head in one breed, that breed will show in an Any Other Breed class.
- Exhibitors must provide registration papers on purebred breeding sheep. Ewes without proper papers will show as a commercial ewe. All sheep must carry an ear tag corresponding to registration papers. All female and sexually intact males need scrapie tags.
- Purchased sheep must be purchased by June 1, 2021. If the animal was purchased late, bring a bill of sale in the exhibitor's name.
- Ewe & Ram Classes: Yearling Ewe/Rams must be born after September 1, 2019. Ram and ewe lamb classes will be split into January, February and March and after classes.
- Two exhibitors are allowed to show breeding sheep, the exhibitor of the sheep entered must be on head.
- Market Lamb Classes: Lambs must be born after January 1, 2021.

- Market lamb and commercial ewe entries DO NOT have to be pre-identified—please indicate only how many animals you will be showing.
- No patch shearing is allowed. Lambs must not have more than one-half inch of wool.
- No tubes/blankets allowed on lambs during weigh-in, they will be allowed over the scale one time with breed/weight determined.

**GOAT RULES:**

- Up to 4 Market Wether/Commercial Doe goats may be shown per exhibitor—Meat Goats Only.
- Goats must be born after January 1, 2021.
- Goats will be shown by gender/weight. Meat goat exhibitors will declare weights in 2021. A scale will be available if needed.
- Goats must be clipped and fit for show in order to participate.
- ALL species in 2021 will show out of trailer.
